

PBOT Construction Notice for Rose City Golf Course – Coming soon

Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is constructing a new neighborhood greenway route between SE Flavel Street and NE Sacramento Street around the '70s' numbered avenues. As they look to increase access for biking and walking, Rose City Golf Course will see some impacts during construction.

Construction is scheduled to begin soon, and once started is estimated to last four (4) weeks. **Rose City Golf Course and the clubhouse will remain open throughout entirety of construction.**

Here is what Rose City Golf Course guests can expect during PBOT construction (see diagram):

- Access and parking in the eastern most row of parking will **temporarily** be closed for pedestrian use
- Use Southwestern entrance on Tillamook to enter parking lot
- Parking lot entrance on NE 72nd Drive by clubhouse will be open during construction
- **10th hole crossing will be closed during construction**
- A temporary pedestrian crossing for golfers will be established near the south end of the putting green for golfers playing the back 9
- Golf carts traveling to 10th tee will need to use 18th hole crossing. Again, 10th hole crossing will be closed during construction
- ALL golf cart and push cart traffic should remain left (north) and off of the 10th tee during construction
