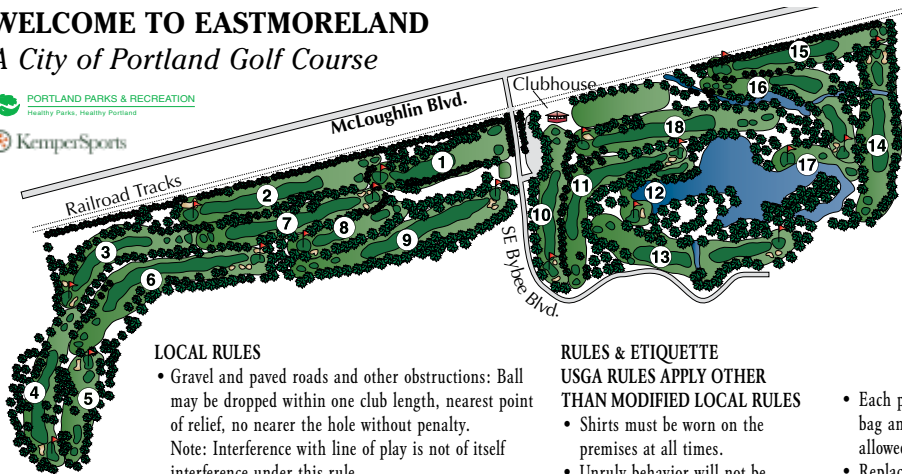

LOCAL RULES

- Gravel and paved roads and other obstructions: Ball may be dropped within one club length, nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole without penalty.
Note: Interference with line of play is not of itself interference under this rule.
- Out of bounds: Designated by white stakes, boundary fence posts, and white lines.
- Drop away from all staked or screened trees.
No penalty.
- Play embedded ball rule through the green.
- Water hazard: Designated by yellow stakes and/or lines.
- Lateral hazard: Designated by red stakes and/or lines.
- No outside alcohol is permitted on property.

RULES & ETIQUETTE

USGA RULES APPLY OTHER THAN MODIFIED LOCAL RULES

- Shirts must be worn on the premises at all times.
- Unruly behavior will not be allowed on the premises. Those persons using obscene language, being obnoxious or intoxicated, may be asked to leave.
- The golfer is responsible for injury or damage to property resulting from errant golf balls.
- Each player must have their own bag and clubs. No fivesomes allowed.
- Replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake bunkers.
- Speed of Play: For the consideration of others, all groups are required to complete each hole in less than 15 minutes or 18 holes in 4½ hours. Slow groups may be asked to move forward.
